Agenda topic Football | Presenter

#### Uniforms:

- Majority would like to see a new supplier for pants.
- Looking for a new vendor for Jerseys and pants.

Rod agreed to take command of the Flag Football Program for 2025.. As it's his first year, Steve will help him with what tasks need to be completed and when.

Steve would like to reach out to Varsity head coach about having high school players be refs instead of parent volunteers

An adjustment is needed for the attendance policy, and will be reflected when registering athletes –If you miss school for illness, you may not attend practice.

Football registration will see an increase this year. Price increase primarily due to cost of equipment and general price increases from vendors.

### Agenda topic Cheer | Presenter Jade

Outstanding Champion bill of 49.98 was paid and receipt given to the treasurer.

Cheer uniform colors will be Carolina Blue and Navy Blue, Ombre style. Replacing jacket with crew neck this season due to feedback from coaches and parents. Because of this change we will not be increasing the cost of cheer registration. Bags are included, but we are waiting on the Champion rep to confirm cost of shoes. Keeping Registration the same price- \$275.00. Uniforms must be ordered by May 9th. Jade informed us that we need to spend \$4500.00 to keep our 5% discount– board approved purchasing bows and poms now.

#### Agenda topic Registrations | Presenter

#### Agenda topic Other Items | Presenter

The Director of Cheer and Commissioner will present coach choices to the board to approve prior to season starting.

Cheer- 3 coaching staff per team (Head Coach, Assistant Coach, Team Parent)
Football- 6 Coaches minimum per team (Head Defensive Coach, Head Offensive Coach,
